Daily Itinerary

MARCH 1/SUN – DEPART JFK TO ROME.

MARCH 2/MON – ARRIVE ROME. Upon arrival to Rome Fiumicino Airport, meet your tour manager and coach driver and begin your sightseeing tour of Rome! We will visit Rome's Major Basilica's. Our first stop is to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th Century and the burial place of Saint Paul the Apostle. Visit St. John Lateran Basilica, the oldest of the four major Basilicas in Rome and the home to the relics of Peter and Paul. Cross the street to the Holy Staircase (Scala Santa). Tradition states that this staircase is from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus and was brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. If time permits, you may climb the steps on your knees in memory of Christ's agonizing Passion. Next stop is the Basilica of St. Mary Major which contains a relic from the Manger of the Infant Jesus. It is also the resting place of Pope Francis. Celebrate Mass (location to be advised), then transfer to your hotel in Rome for check-in, dinner and overnight. (D)

MARCH 3/TUE – ROME. After breakfast, we will have a full day of sightseeing. Meet your local guide for a guided walking tour of historic Rome. Visit the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, Via del Corso, the Pantheon and Piazza Navona. Enjoy some free time for lunch on your own. Visit the Church of Saint Alphonsus Liguori for Mass and to admire the Icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help which hangs above the main altar. Celebrate Mass, perhaps here at St. Alphonsus Church. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

MARCH 4/WED - ROME. Rise early today to attend the Papal Audience with our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV! After the Papal Audience, you will have some free time to explore the inside of St. Peter's Basilica on your own. After, you have some more leisure time for lunch on your own. In the afternoon, tour the impressive Vatican Museums. Walk through some of the most unique rooms and view masterpieces of famous artists and marvel at the Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's work of art, the "Last Judgment." Return back to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

MARCH 5/THU - ROME/COLLEVALENZA/ASSISI. After breakfast, board your coach and depart towards Assisi. En-route, we will visit the Sanctuary of Merciful Love of Collevaenza and its healing spring waters. Continue on to Assisi, the birthplace of St. Francis, arriving in time for lunch on your own. Take a tour of St. Mary of the Angels Basilica in Assisi's Lower Town. This Basilica is where St. Francis spent most of life and is made up of two structures; the Porziuncola where St. Francis founded his order of the Friar Minor (Franciscans), and the Cappella del Transito, which is the place of St. Francis' death. Visit the beautiful Rose Garden where St. Francis and other friars lived, as well as the cave where the Saint retired to pray. Our tour continues in Assisi's Upper Town where we will visit St. Clare Basilica and St. Mary Major Church which contains the tomb of St. Carlo Acutis, the first millennial Saint! Finally, we enter St. Francis Basilica where we will see the open tomb of St. Francis. Admire the series of frescoes depicting his life and view some of his relics. Celebrate Mass, then check-in to your hotel here in Assisi for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

MARCH 6/FRI - ASSISI. After breakfast, minivans and our local tour guide will greet us outside the hotel to begin today's sightseeing. Visit the Sanctuary of San Damiano, St. Clare Convent and Carceri Hermitage, the woodside home of St. Francis. Return to your hotel in Assisi for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

MARCH 7/SAT - ASSISI/GRECCIO/LA VERNA/TUSCANY. After breakfast, board your coach and depart towards Tuscany! En-route, stop in Greccio and La Verna to discover the sites where the first Nativity Scenes were created by St. Francis, and where he received the Stigmata. In the evening, continue to the Val d'Elsa region in Tuscany. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D) **HOTEL VILLA SAN LUCCHESI or similar** www.villasanlucchese.com

MARCH 8/SUN - TUSCANY/ROME. After breakfast, board your coach and depart to nearby Siena, the city of St. Catherine, the great Mystic Saint, Doctor of the Church and Patron Saint of Italy! We will enjoy a guided tour of the historic city center, and celebrate Mass in the Church of St. Francis, home to the Eucharistic Miracle. We will also have the opportunity to witness the cup containing the miracle of the sacred host up close! Board your coach and return back to Rome. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)
