SEP 14/MON: Depart JFK on your nonstop flight to Lisbon.

SEP 15/TUE – Lisbon/Santarem/Fatima. On arrival to Lisbon Airport, meet your English speaking tour manager and coach and depart to Fatima, site where the Virgin Mary appeared to three shepherd children monthly from May 13 to October 13, 1917. Visit Our Lady of the Rosary Basilica and the Sanctuary followed by Mass in Apparition Chapel. Check-in to your hotel and enjoy some time to rest and refresh before dinner. After dinner, you will have the opportunity to participate in the evening Rosary procession with pilgrims from around the world! (D)

SEP 16/WED - Fatima. After breakfast, depart to Aljustrel where the three children were born. We will also visit Valinhos, the site of the 4th Apparition. Follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra, ending in the Chapel of Calvary which overlooks all of Fatima. Lunch on your own followed by concelebrated Mass in the Chapel of the Apparitions. After, visit the spectacular Shrine and the new Church of the Santíssima Trinidad (Holy Trinity Church). After dinner at your hotel, you may wish to participate once more in the evening candlelight procession. (B,D)

SEP 17/THU: Fatima/Santiago de Compostela. Early morning departure to Santiago de Compostela. Visit Santiago Cathedral where St. James the Apostle's tomb lies and take a tour to explore the many plazas and churches in the historic center and celebrate Mass. Time permitting, you may wish to return to the Cathedral to experience the 7:30 pm pilgrim's Mass. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

SEP 18/FRI: Santiago de Compostela/Garabandal. Morning departure towards the mountain town of Garabandal, where four school girls saw the Apparition of the Archangel Michael and the Virgin Mary between 1961 and 1965. Tour the town and visit San Sebastian Church. Visit the Sanctuary of the Pines where the Apparitions occurred. Celebrate Mass followed by check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

SEP 19/SAT: Garabandal/Loyola/Lourdes. Morning departure to Lourdes. Stop en-route in Loyola to visit Loyola Sanctuary. Today's Mass will be held in the Chapel of the Blessed Gate. Lunch on own, then board your coach and continue on to Lourdes. On arrival, check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. You will have an opportunity to participate in the evening candlelight procession after dinner with pilgrims from around the world. It is very special to experience! (B,D) **Hotel Panorama or similar www.hotelpanoramalourdes.com**

SEP 20/SUN: Lourdes. After breakfast, concelebrate morning Mass at the Grotto. After, meet your local guide to visit the Basilica of St. Pius X, the Church of the Rosary and take a walking tour to see the sites associated with Bernadette's life in Lourdes. You will have free time to experience the healing baths / water gesture. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. You will have another opportunity to participate in the candlelight procession or pray the Rosary. (B,D)

SEP 21/MON: Lourdes/Zaragoza/Valencia. Depart your hotel at 7 AM and drive towards Valencia. En-route, stop in Zaragoza to visit Our Lady of the Pillar Basilica (Mass), built on the site where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. James the Apostle. See the pillar the Virgin Mary is said to have arrived on and learn about Spain's great history of Marian Apparitions. Continue to Valencia, the vibrant Mediterranean city. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D) **Hotel Eurostars Gran Valencia or similar www.eurostarshotels.com**

SEP 22/TUE: Valencia/Barcelona. After breakfast, visit Valencia Cathedral for Mass in El Caliz Chapel which houses the Holy Grail, believed to be the cup used by Jesus at the Last Supper. Receive your plenary indulgence as it is a Jubilee Year of the Holy Grail! Then take a guided tour of the historic center followed by lunch on your own. Depart towards Barcelona, making a stop en-route at the world famous LLadro Factory for browsing and shopping. Continue on to Barcelona, the colorful coastal Mediterranean city. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D) **Hotel HCC Montblanc or similar www.hcshotels.com**

SEP 23/WED: Barcelona (Montserrat Excursion). After breakfast, board your coach and depart to the Monastery of Montserrat, perched high on sheer rock rising above the Catalonia plains. Celebrate Mass at world famous Shrine of the Black Madonna (Mass in the Chapel of the Virgin). Return back to Barcelona, enjoying a panoramic orientation tour as we make our way back to your hotel. Enjoy a bit of free time before dinner and overnight at your hotel. (B,D)

SEP 24/THU: Barcelona. Today is the feast day of Our Lady of Mercy and the city comes alive with celebrations and music. Our day begins with concelebrated Mass at Barcelona Cathedral in the Chapel of the Holy Sacrament. After, enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic quarter with Las Ramblas, Plaza del Rey, Park Guell and Sagrada Família Basilica. Return to your hotel to freshen up before dinner out at a local restaurant within walking distance of your hotel. Wine is included! (B)

SEP 25/FRI: RETURN FLIGHT BACK TO HOME. Transfer to Barcelona Airport for your return flight back to JFK. (B)

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Regularly scheduled economy class service on any IATA or ARC carrier.

TARIFF & EXCHANGE FLUCTUATIONS: Estimated tour price herein is quoted in U.S. dollars and are based on tariffs and exchange levels in effect January 2026. Rates are subject to adjustment in the event of any changes in these tariffs and exchange levels.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Rooms with two beds and private bath throughout.

DOCUMENTS: Carry valid U.S. passport valid through December 25, 2026 or beyond and another photo ID. Beginning in the third quarter of 2026, it is expected that the ETIAS Travel Authorization will be required to enter Portugal, Spain and France. The approximate cost is \$23 and must be applied for online by each traveler. At the time of this printing in January 2026, the ETIAS rollout date has NOT yet been announced, however Far Away Tours will provide further details when more information is available.

CANCELLATIONS: Upon deposit, a non-refundable fee of \$250 will secure your spot on the trip. After that, cancellation fees are as follows: 200-160 days prior: \$750 ;159-100 days prior: \$1,500; 99-65 days prior: \$3,000; 64-0 days prior: up to total cost. In addition, airline tickets are nonrefundable from the day they are issued, which is sometimes several months before departure. For this reason, optional cancellation/travel protection insurance is highly recommended at time of deposit to protect your travel investment.
