In 1970, Bishop Mugavero invited a group of Xaverian brothers to set up programs in liturgy, youth ministry and adult religious education for the nine parishes of Flushing. Among several projects directed by representatives of each parish acting as the Flushing Modular Planning Project, the brothers created an innovative multi-parish teenage retreat program, usually called the **Flushing Module Youth Program**. After the brothers' contract ended in June 1972, the teens asked some of the adults who had trained with the brothers to continue the program. A team consisting of adults and youth from each parish developed a proposal that was approved by the Flushing parishes. On May 6, 1973, the first "day" (Search Day) was produced in St. Michael's basement hall on Barclay Avenue. Something new was born. Some years later, the name was changed to the **Module Youth Program of Northeast Queens** to include Bayside, Douglaston, Whitestone, and College Point parishes.
